	<p>First little talk</p> <p>We are going to continue with Rosa Bonheur’s paintings.</p> <p>Recap last weeks “Wild horses on the plains”.</p> <p>This week have a look at the difference in the horses in the foreground vs background in “Study in light and shade”</p>
<p>Observe</p>	<p>See attached file of Bonheur: <i>Study in light and shade</i></p> <p>Turn the picture over and have a look at it carefully for 2-3 minutes.</p> <p>In intervals, tell your child to notice the colours. Then the lines. Then the shapes. What is in the foreground? The background? And the middle ground?</p>
<p>Discussion (2nd little talk)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What does this painting make you feel? Why? • What do you think about how the artist showed shadow and light?
<p>Response (Activity ideas)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Close your eyes and see how much you can remember. • Try and paint or draw this picture in your way (or part of it) or paint one of the trees in your garden
